

# STRING OF HEARTS

## REGION OF ORIGIN

southern Africa



### LIGHT

String of Hearts thrives in bright, indirect sunlight, ideally from a southern exposure. Some direct morning or evening sun can enhance its growth and variegation, provided it's not too intense



### SOIL

We favor well-draining mediums like Rooted Goods All-Purpose Potting Mix or Uncle Mike's Organic Potting Mix. To enhance drainage mix 2/3 potting soil with 1/3 coarse sand or rinsed gravel. Espoma's Organic Cactus Mix is excellent for succulents, too. Using a shallow pot with drainage holes helps prevent overwatering.



### WATER

Water thoroughly, allowing the soil to dry slightly between waterings. Reduced watering needs during the dormant season when growth slows.



### FERTILIZER

For succulents, we recommend using fertilizers like Espoma Organic Cactus Plant Food, Jack's All Purpose, or Organic Plant Magic. These options provide essential nutrients to keep your plants vibrant and thriving. Feed every 4 to 6 weeks during active growing seasons.



### TEMPERATURE

Maintain temperatures between 60-85°F (16-29°C) for optimal growth. String of Hearts are sensitive to cold temperatures below 50 degrees.



### ISSUES + FIXES

Watch for pests like mealybugs and scale, and ensure good ventilation and regular cleaning to prevent issues.



### PRUNING & PROPAGATION

Propagate through stem cuttings in spring or summer, allowing the cut end to callus before planting. Calloused cuttings can be propagated in water until roots form, or directly into moist soil.
