

LOW LIGHT PLANTS

Low-light plants are the perfect way to add a splash of life and color to any gloomy office or room. Low light refers to a room with little natural light. These rooms usually have small or obstructed windows. Reminder, that even low-light plants need some light! Be sure not to overwater them, as they won't dry out as quickly in low light conditions. Additionally, keep in mind that the specific lighting conditions in your home may vary, so it's a good idea to monitor your plants and adjust their placement as needed to ensure their well-being.
