

# PARLOR PALM

## REGION OF ORIGIN

Honduras



### LIGHT

Thriving in bright indirect sunlight from the North, East, or West, the Parlor palm appreciates filtered light to flourish, but can adapt to lower light conditions. Avoid harsh direct sunlight to prevent leaf burn.



### SOIL

For palm trees mix 2/3 Rooted Goods All-Purpose Potting Mix or Uncle Mike's Organic Potting Mix and 1/3 coarse gardening sand. Alternatively, you can use Espoma's Organic Cactus Mix.



### WATER

Maintain evenly moist soil, avoiding acidic rainwater. Opt for tepid water to quench its thirst, and never let the plant sit in standing water. Parlor Palms love higher humidity, so misting the plant occasionally or placing it near a humidifier will help it maintain its look.



### FERTILIZER

We recommend fertilizers like Espoma Organic Palm Tone, Jack's Houseplant Special, or Organic Plant Magic. These options provide essential nutrients to keep your plants vibrant and thriving. Apply during the growing season.



### TEMPERATURE

Provide a cozy environment with temperatures between 60-85°F ensuring a comfortable habitat year-round. Avoid drafts and sudden temperature changes, which can stress the plant.



### ISSUES + FIXES

Vigilance against scale and spider mites is key. Regular inspection and prompt treatment with insecticidal soap or neem oil safeguard against infestations. Yellow leaves are a common sign of overwatering, while crispy, brown tips are indicative of the opposite.



### PRUNING & PROPAGATION

For patient gardeners, propagate through seeds in the spring using a blend of moist peat and perlite. Encourage growth by providing indirect sunlight and maintaining high humidity.
