

# AMARYLLIS BULBS

*Enjoy spectacular blooms indoors with just a few simple steps!*

## *Planting*

Choose a pot about 2" wider than the bulb with a drainage hole. Use lightweight potting soil and plant so the top third ("shoulders") of the bulb sits above the soil.

## *Water & Light*

Lightly water after planting and place in a bright, warm spot. Water sparingly until growth appears, then keep the soil just moist – never soggy.

## *Bloom Time*

Bulbs usually bloom in 6–8 weeks. For faster results, pick a bulb showing green growth at the top.

## *After Blooming*

Remove faded flowers but keep the leaves. Continue watering and feeding monthly – this allows the bulb to recharge.

## *Dormancy*

After about 9 months, when foliage yellows, stop watering and store the bulb in a cool, dry place for 8–12 weeks. When ready to regrow, repot in fresh soil, water lightly, and return to warmth and light.

*Follow this yearly cycle bloom, growth, recharge, rest  
for gorgeous flowers year after year!*
