How to Care for it

Since the wax seals in moisture and nutrients, the bulb grows and flowers on its own - no pot or watering required.

Choose the Right Spot

Place your bulb in a bright location out of direct sun. Too much direct light can scorch the emerging foliage.

Let it Grow Naturally

There's no need to water; the wax coating protects the bulb and holds everything it needs to bloom.

Rotate for Even Growth

If the stem leans toward the light, rotate the bulb every few days to encourage upright, balanced growth.

Enjoy the Blooms

Most bulbs bloom within 6–8 weeks, producing large, colorful flowers perfect for the holiday season.

After It Blooms

Wax-covered bulbs are typically enjoyed for one season. Once the flowers fade, the bulb can be discarded or the wax removed if you'd like to try replanting, though results may vary.
