

# VENUS FLY TRAP

## REGION OF ORIGIN

Eastern United States



### LIGHT

Thrives in full sunlight from the north, east, or west.



### SOIL

Use a nutrient-poor, acidic medium, such as a mix of sphagnum moss and sand.



### WATER

Water with distilled water. Keep the soil consistently moist; avoid letting it dry out completely between waterings.



### FERTILIZER

Not necessary, but occasional feeding with bugs or a monthly fertilization during spring through fall is beneficial.



### TEMPERATURE

Venus fly traps prefer a warm humid environment. Keep cool in winter to mimic its natural habitat.



### ISSUES + FIXES

Rarely troubled by pests; inspect new plants for pests before introducing them.



### PRUNING & PROPAGATION

Propagate by division or seeds in spring, ensuring proper moisture and light conditions for successful growth.



### PET FRIENDLY ?

While non-toxic for pets, avoid letting them consume plants as it can lead to minor stomach upset.
